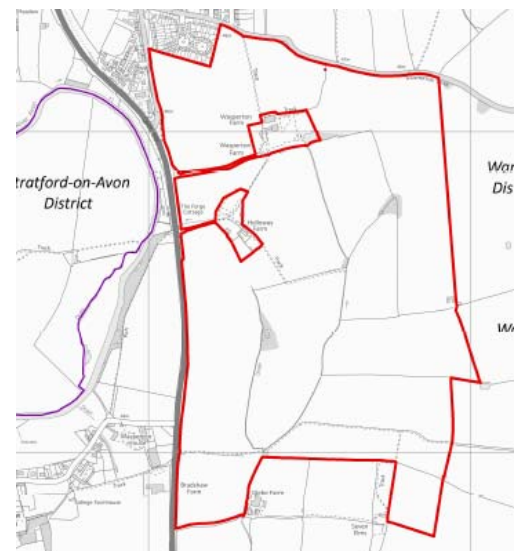

DEADLINE 4th DECEMBER 2015

Warwickshire County Council is producing a new Minerals Development Framework to replace the 1995 Minerals Local Plan. This new plan will identify where new minerals sites should be located, and if these sites go into the plan will have prospect of planning applications hanging over us for the next 15-20 years

Grounds for objection can include

- Loss of grade 1,2 and 3a agricultural land
- Re-instatement proposal inaccurate and misleading:
 - insufficient inert waste available
 - lowered ground level will render land unviable for agriculture
- Viability of Glebe Farm – area of extraction overstated, loss of tenant farm facility
- Blight on property prices
- Negative Health effects on residents, dust, noise, mental health
- Access Issues onto A429
- Insufficient detail to proposal
- Increased use of recycled materials – reduction in need for sand and gravel extraction
- Proximity to conservation areas – Wasperton and Barford
- Proximity to listed buildings – protecting heritage assets

The more INDIVIDUAL letters of objection received by county, the greater the impact.

Several short but specific letters from one household carry more weight than one long detailed letter. So ensure spouses and “young residents” submit their own letter

Do not use one template as if obviously the same it will **only** count as 1 Objection
