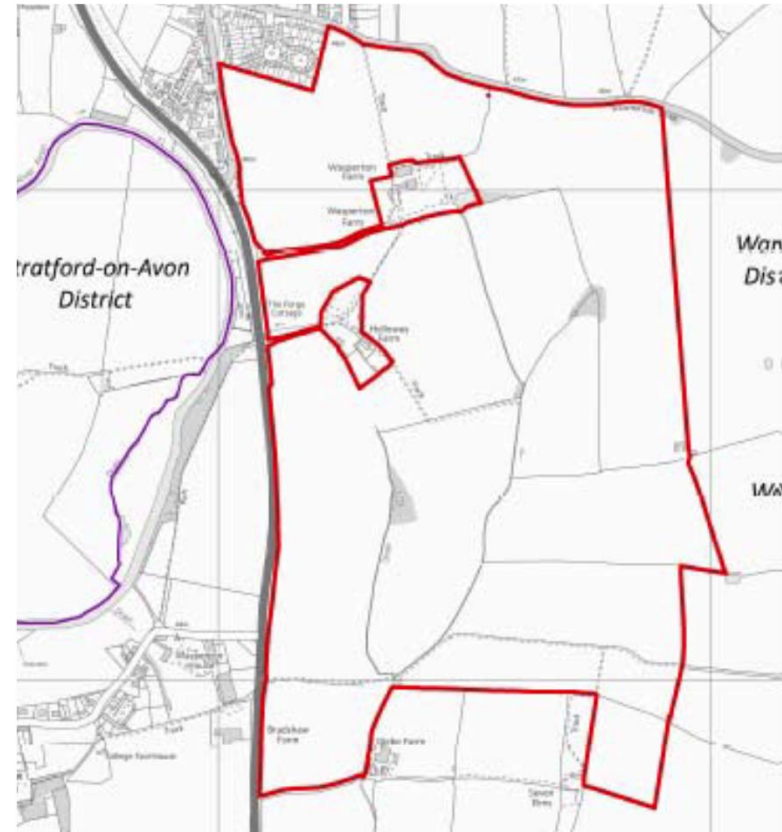


Original Sites (Dec 2015)

County has written Revised Plan

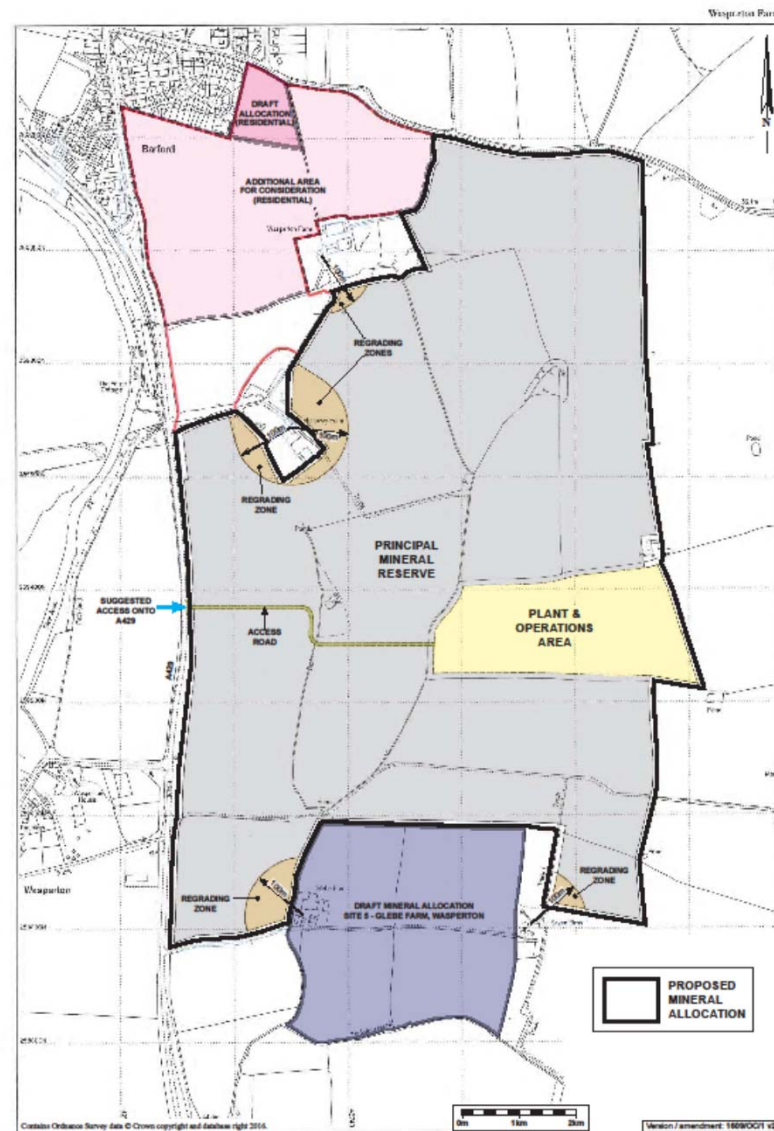
Response to previous consultation/Revised Plan not on Minerals Portal,

What Has Changed (Dec 2016)

- Site 4 – now 350m off stand BUT Additional Area for Residential Consideration
- Proposed Common Access Road onto A429
- Site 5 Unchanged
